On Thursday 12th April at 2:30pm there will be an 'Easter Bonnet Parade' for all Reception and KS1 children and an 'Easter Vehicle Competition' for all KS2 children. Easter Bonnet Parade

Children in Reception and KS1 need to make their own imaginative Easter bonnet that they can wear on their heads whilst parading around the playground. Make it as colourful and creative as possible. There will be prizes for the best Easter bonnets.



Easter Vehicle Competition

Children in KS2 need to make their own imaginative vehicle that can carry a hard-boiled egg safely from one point to another. The vehicle must have at least 3 wheels, be made out of materials which are available, excluding ready-made construction kits like K'nex or Lego. All vehicles will be tested and there will be prizes for the best Easter vehicles. The categories are: 'Best Design', 'Longest Distance Travelled' and 'Most Original Solution'.



All bonnets and vehicles will need to be in school by the Wednesday afternoon (11th April), so that they can be used to decorate the hall for the school's Easter assembly on the Thursday morning.
