<b>Class 1</b>	Miss Ray will inform parents which costumes their child will require
<b>Class 2</b>	Townfolk - black trousers or leggings (no jeans). Shirt with checks or stripes
<b>Class 3</b>	Imaginary celebrities - black trousers or leggings (no jeans) with patterned party tops / sequins / sparkly (not crop tops) Any choir members see below
<b>Class 4</b>	Shiny stars - black trousers / leggings (no jeans) White, grey, or silver tops with a length of silver tinsel (no crop tops or tops with logos) Any choir members see below
<b>Class 5</b>	Black trousers / leggings (no jeans). Tops (no logos) of various 'royal' colours: red, gold, blue, emerald green, purple.
<b>Choir</b>	Angels - black trousers / leggings too (no jeans). We may have some costumes in school but if you have an angel costume that would be helpful.
