Dear Parents/Carers

Class 2 Visit to Stourhead Estate on Tuesday 14th November

As part of our research question '*How can I be a good Story-teller?*' Class 2 will be making a visit to the woods on the Stourhead Estate on **Tuesday 14th November**. We will be gathering ideas about settings and characters to help us with our story-telling. Please try not to let your child know about the trip, as the quality of their creative thinking will be much better if they are not aware until I tell them!

On the day of the trip, the children will need to wear:

- Warm school uniform sweatshirt and polo shirt
- A pair of warm old trousers along with waterproof trousers if possible; it will be very muddy!
- A warm waterproof coat
- Sturdy wellington boots that can withstand deep puddles (please bring their named boots in a carrier bag)
- Additional socks are also a very good idea along with hats and gloves
- Clean school trousers for our return

We will be leaving school at 9:10am and returning at about 1:15pm to eat our lunch. We will not return in time for hot school meals, so your child will need to bring a packed lunch on that day. Hot school meals have been cancelled for this day. If the weather is really bad (pouring with rain) we will hopefully go on **Wednesday 15th November** instead. If we do have to postpone, then children will still need to bring a packed lunch on Tuesday as well as one for Wednesday.

The children will be accompanied by Miss McLaurie, Miss Rees, Miss Nicholas and 3 parent helpers (please come and let me know if you would like to help on this trip).

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£7** per child to help cover the cost of the transport and parking. Our method of payment is via Tucasi online which also automatically logs your consent for your child to attend. Contributions from families on free school meals will not be required. If you have any problems using the online system, please contact the school office. We require your payment/consent by **Friday 10th November**.
