Costumes

In preparation for the performance, Mrs Jenkins is requesting that children bring in the following costumes to school in a named bag:

Pioneer Class (Class 1)	Puppies - White, brown, black, grey t-shirts and white, brown, black, grey tights/leggings to make your own choice of puppy colours. Please indicate consent / non-consent for simple face-painting of puppy noses below*
Explorer Class (Class 2)	Holiday-makers – modest beachwear, (no swim wear required!), shorts, vest tops and T-shirts. Named accessories such as hats, sunglasses and buckets and spades welcome!
Discovery Class (Class 3)	Shoppers - casual shopping wear + accessories, such as handbags, wallets, purses, shopping bags / paper-handled bags / named toy or sealed box game that you might choose to buy in a shop (nothing valuable, sentimental, too big or heavy please)
Voyager Class (Class 4)	Firefighters – dark trousers / black T-shirts, (hi-viz jackets provided by school) Elephants - grey / dark trousers/ grey T-shirts. (Staff will make simple elephant ears / trunks as required) Puppies - White, brown, black, grey t-shirts and white, brown, black, grey tights/leggings to make your own choice of puppy colours. Please indicate consent / non-consent for simple face-painting of puppy noses below*

The three dates are as follows:


Wednesday 17 th July at 10:00am
