

Music Lesson: Year 3 & 4: use link for Y4 as it extends the learning for Y3 children if they wish to.

Go to BBC Bitesize KS2 Music Y4 1 May - 'Learn about pulse and rhythm'.

Video 1: this is a fun revision cartoon clip explaining what pulse and rhythm are. (I am hoping that you will remember 'pulse' and 'rhythm' from our music learning in school).

Then you get to explore pulse and rhythm using BODY PERCUSSION! which we also like to do in school!

Scottish composer, 'Anna Meredith' shows more body percussion sounds and movements for you to try at home!

Activity 1 & 2: try out different body percussion sounds and see how sounds can be shown as 'layers' in a grid.

Try making up some word rhythms yourself. Write them down so you don't forget them!

Activity 3:

You can see and hear Anna Meredith's piece 'Connect It'.

Copy the different sounds and movements at home - there are 8 altogether!

Choose your favourite 3 and try and remember them!

See how all the rhythms connect.

See if you can keep going for the whole piece with the children on screen.
